1925 Bentley 3 Litre Supersports owned by Bob Cole of Woodside, California is one of 17, a Green Label 100 MPH Brooklands

Built in Detroit, known then as Petite Princess, the company closed its doors in 1916, this 1914 Petite Speciale owned by George Knapp of Fresno, California

The first Plus 4 imported to the West Coast, displayed at Pebble Beach at the 100 year anniversary of Morgan Motorcars owned by Bob & Ben La Mar Half Moon Bay, CA
